



## Digital Learning- Student Expectations Concordia Jr-Sr High School

### School is moving online?

- Your classes will still 'meet' but in a different way.
- Teachers will assign material.
- You will complete the work.
- Teachers will be available for help.
- You will submit work online.
- Teachers will post grades as usual.

### I have to go to school at home every day?

- Yes.
- Check Canvas and your email every day.
  - Teachers will post assignments to Canvas by 9:00am.
- Do every assignment the teachers give.
- If daily submissions are late (after 11:59 on the day due), you are considered absent that day.

### Will there be different school hours?

- Teachers will have assignments posted to Canvas by 9:00 am.
- Teachers will answer questions during the regular school day (9:00am - 3:10pm).
- Teachers will let you know if they will be available to answer questions outside of school hours.

### How will teachers 'teach' and how do I ask questions?

- All teachers will explain their expectations to students.
  - Expectations will be posted to Canvas.
- Teachers will also be online and posting feedback and comments to digital lessons and answering questions during the school day.
  - Questions can be posted to teacher through email or posting a note to Canvas.
  - Teachers will answer questions during regular school day (9:00am-3:10pm), questions asked outside of the school day will be answered within 24 hours.
- Teachers will also be available by email during the school day for questions as needed.
- To ask a question on Canvas:
  - Go to the Inbox on the left side of the home screen in Canvas.
  - Click 'Compose a Message'.
  - Select the course and teacher you wish to send the message to.
  - Compose the message.
  - Click 'Send'.
- Teachers will be available through ZOOM (check Canvas for details) for the following times:
  - All Math and Science teachers: Every day from 9:00am-11:00am
  - All Religion and English teachers: Tuesday and Thursday 11:00am-1:00pm
  - Contact all other teachers to schedule a phone call.
- Concordia Learning Plans are still in effect.

### How long do I have to complete assignments?

- Due date expectations will not change.
  - Teacher will inform students of the expectations.
- Grades will be posted in a timely manner.
- If your teachers have assigned a project, there will be a turn-in location in the front office.

### What are the expectations?

- Expectations:
  - Check Canvas every day for new assignments/deadlines.
  - Check your email daily.
  - Complete all assigned work.
  - Submit all work electronically.
  - Contact your teachers for help or with questions.

### What about my grades?

- Teachers will give grades and feedback.
- If you don't do an assignment, you will receive a zero.
- If you are sick, deadlines will be adjusted as needed. Contact your teachers to let them know you are sick.
- Abide by your teachers' usual late work policies.
- Teachers will post daily on Canvas.
- Ask for help if you need it.

### What if...?

- I have issues with technology?
  - Email your teacher(s) immediately.
  - Use your cell phone or a home desktop or laptop as a backup to your iPad.
