



## Concordia Digital Learning: FAQs

### How will digital learning lessons be delivered?

- Concordia Junior High (6-8) and Concordia High School (9-12)
  - Teachers will assign timely and relevant lessons through Canvas as soon as possible, but no later than 9:00 AM.
  - Students are expected to follow the instructions given to them as found on Canvas. Teachers will create lessons that involve relevant curricular content followed by an assignment.
  - Lessons could include an assignment that requires students to submit completed material that same day, or teachers may have an assignment that is due on a future date. Completion and grading of work will follow each teacher's normal practice of classroom procedures.

### How will teachers communicate with students on a digital learning day?

- All teachers will explain their expectations to students.
  - Expectations will be posted to Canvas.
- Teachers will also be online and posting feedback and comments to digital lessons and answering questions during the school day.
  - Teachers will answer questions during regular school day (9:00am-3:10pm), questions asked outside of the school day will be answered within 24 hours.
- Teachers will also be available by email during the school day for questions as needed.

### How can students ask questions through Canvas?

- Go to the Inbox on the left side of the home screen in Canvas.
- Click 'Compose a Message'.
- Select the course and teacher you wish to send the message to.
- Compose the message.
- Click 'Send'.
- Teachers will also be available to chat online through Zoom.
  - All Math and Science teachers: 9:00am-11:00am
  - All Religion and English teachers: Tuesday and Thursday 11:00am-1:00pm
  - Contact all other teachers to schedule a time.

### How long do students have to complete their digital learning day assignment before they are recorded absent?

- Students who do not complete the assignment from a digital learning day will be marked absent following the reporting periods listed above.
- Every class will have a daily assignment.
- Assignment Due date expectations will not change.
  - Teachers will inform students of the expectations.
- Concordia Learning Plans will still be in effect.

### **How will teachers provide feedback on lessons?**

- In Canvas, teachers can add comments on student work.
- In Canvas, teachers can provide private or class feedback for each student's submitted work, in addition to any comments made within individual assignments in Google Docs, Drawings, Slides, etc.
- Feedback can also be automatic through the use of Canvas quizzes.
- Teachers may communicate via email to parents or students who may have clarifying questions, or to confirm that work has been received and is understood.

### **What happens if a student does not complete the digital learning day assignment?**

- The student would be counted absent by the classroom teacher for that school day or period.
- Teachers will communicate with parents of students who did not do their work for the digital learning day to check in, offer support, and discuss options for making up the work.
