Position Summary

The Concordia Club Adult Lead is responsible for opening or closing the Concordia Club program daily as well as organizing and overseeing a range of activities for children either before (7-8 AM) or after (3-6 PM or 1:30-6 PM on early dismissal days) school hours. This role ensures a safe, engaging, and enriching environment for all participants. The ideal candidate will be enthusiastic, organized, and committed to providing a positive experience for children.

Position Responsibilities

1. Oversee a daily schedule of activities for K-8 students either before (7-8 AM) or after school (3-6 PM or 1:30-6 PM on early dismissal days) Monday through Friday.
2. Ensure children's safety by constantly supervising them through sound and sight.
3. Organize Concordia Club support staff workers to ensure appropriate supervision in all student areas (outside on the playground and in classrooms).
4. Manage and organize program materials, equipment, and arranged spaces.
5. Assist in the setup and cleanup of activity areas to create an inviting, pleasant, and tidy atmosphere for children
6. Oversee use of the school information system (FACTS) and monitor students' check-in/check-out
7. Enforce program rules and manage behavior in a positive and constructive manner.
8. Communicate effectively with parents, guardians, and school staff about program activities and child progress.
9. Provide homework assistance
10. Administer basic first aid as needed and follow proper incident reporting procedures.

Skills Necessary

1. Strong leadership and organizational skills.
2. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
3. Ability to manage multiple tasks and adapt to changing program needs.
4. Basic first aid and CPR certification preferred.
5. Basic proficiency in using technology and educational software preferred.

Professional Expectations and Requirements

1. Desire to serve in a non-profit educational environment
2. High school diploma or equivalent required; Associate's degree or higher in Education or related field preferred.
3. Previous experience working with children in a group setting, preferably in a school or recreational program is highly desirable.
